MEMORIAL ASSEMBLY
FORMER PRESIDENT DWIGHT DAVID EISENHOWER

Monday, March 31, 1969

PRESIDENT NIXON HAS PROCLAIMED TODAY AS A NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING IN HONOR OF FORMER PRESIDENT DWIGHT DAVID EISENHOWER. GOVERNOR RAMPTON HAS ASKED UTAH SCHOOLS TO CONDUCT MEMORIAL SERVICES IN HONOR OF THE FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

WE HAVE THEREFORE ASSEMBLED THIS MORNING TO PAY TRIBUTE TO AN HONORABLE CITIZEN-SOLDIER, OUR FORMER COMMANDER IN CHIEF, THE 34TH PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHO DIED FRIDAY, MARCH 28, 1969, AT THE WALTER REED ARMY HOSPITAL IN WASHINGTON, D.C. HE WAS 78 YEARS OLD AND DIED OF A CONGESTIVE HEART FAILURE.

PRESIDENT EISENHOWER FOUGHT TO PRESERVE THE DIGNITY OF OUR AMERICAN HERITAGE. "OLD GLORY" TO THE FORMER FIVE STAR GENERAL WAS IMMORTAL.

THE SOUTH HIGH SCHOOL ROTC CADETS WILL NOW PRESENT THE COLORS. OUR STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT PAUL GUNNELL WILL LEAD US IN THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AFTER WHICH THE INVOCATION WILL BE OFFERED BY BROTHER JACK R. PRICE. FOLLOWING THE INVOCATION MR. JAMES J. CULLIGAN WILL PRESENT A EULOGY TO THE FORMER PRESIDENT.

THE MEMORY AND THE IDEALS OF OUR FORMER COMMANDER IN CHIEF WILL REMAIN WITH US LONG AFTER THE TOLLING OF THE BELLS OR THE ECHOES OF THE CANNON SALUTES HAVE FADED INTO THE HILLS. YES. HE WAS A MAN WHO CAME FROM THE HEART OF AMERICA AND WAS THE PERSONIFICATION OF AMERICA TO THE WORLD.
