Summer graduation exercises at Utah Tech will be held Friday, Aug. 24, in the College's Main Campus Administration Bldg.

At 10 a.m., 108 graduates from various vocational-technical courses will receive their diplomas, certificates and degrees. At 8 p.m., the 47th graduating class of practical nurses will be honored.

At the morning affair, Dr. Harvey C. Hirschi, Administrator of the Division of Rehabilitation services of the Utah State Board of Education, will be the commencement speaker. Degrees, certificates and diplomas will be presented by A. Glen Christensen, a member of the Utah State Board For Vocational Education.

Copper Co. Grant Comes To College

A grant of \$2,050 has been given to Utah Technical College at Salt Lake by the Utah Copper Division of Kennecott Copper Corp.

Utah Copper Division Manager B.B. Smith says \$1,000 of the grant will go to the College's general scholarship fund, and the remainder is earmarked for minority students.

Smith says, "Grants such as this represent our long-standing interest in vocational education, especially that portion which applies to minority people."

In accepting the grant, Utah Technical College President Jay L. Nelson says he lauds Kennecott's interest in the school shown by annual scholarship contributions and employee service on various advisory committees at the College.

"It's contributions such as this that give people a chance to be all that they are capable of being in life," President Nelson said.

This year the largest number of graduates are from electronics, electricity, machine shop and auto mechanics. Other courses listing graduates are accounting, architectural drafting, auto body repair and paint, barbering, business management, cosmetology, executive secretary, general office clerk, marketing, printing, small engine repair, steno and welding.

A buffet luncheon will be held immediately following the graduation program to honor the graduates. The luncheon is free to graduates, but they must pick up their tickets from Hazel Jolley at the Downtown Campus or from the Dean of Students Office on the Main Campus.

Tickets for friends and relatives cost \$1 a person and may also be obtained at any of these locations.

The Friday evening practical nursing graduation program will graduate 48 nurses.

Guest speaker will be Mrs. Jean Larsen, supervisor of the College's health occupations and business programs. Graduation certificates will be presented by Mrs. Lila B. Bjorklund, a member of the Utah State Board For Vocational Education.
