TECH. THE HOLDER OF A MASTER ELECTRICIAN CERTIFICATE, HE HAS BEEN AN

INDEPENDENT ELECTRICIAN SINCE 1958. HE PRESENTLY SERVES ON THE

ELECTRICITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE AT THE COLLEGE.

KEITH SAYS HE FIRST BECAME INTERESTED IN ELECTRICITY THROUGH HIS FATHER, WHO ALSO WAS AN ELECTRICIAN. HIS INTERESTS BECAME A FULL-BLOWN GOAL IN HIGH SCHOOL AND LED TO UTAH TECH.

HE LISTS MUSIC AS HIS ONE HOBBY, AND IS AN ACCOMPLISHED ORGANIST. HIS WIFE'S NAME IS JERRIE, AND THE HALES HAVE FOUR CHILDREN.

NOW KEITH IS CONSIDERED AN EXTREMELY CAREFUL PERSON, BUT WITH SOMEWHAT UNORTHODOX METHODS. AROUND IN THE HALES' KITCHEN CUPBOARD. AFTER KEITH VAINLY TRIED TO

LOCATE THE MOUSE, HE SET A TRAP AND WANDERED OFF TO WATCH TV. A
SHORT WHILE LATER HIS WIFE OPENED THE CUPBOARD AND SPIED THE
MOUSE'S TAIL STICKING OUT OF A CREVICE. BEING THE NORMAL, BRAVE
HOUSEWIFE, JERRIE GRABBED THE MOUSE BY THE TAIL AND CARRIED IT
SQUIRMING INTO THE LIVING ROOM WHERE KEITH WAS WATCHING TV. SHE
