School Offers
Practical
Nurse Training

There simply aren't enough good nurses to go around.

But despite the shortage there's still room for some additional registrations for the class in practical nursing scheduled to begin March 16 at the Salt Lake Area Vocational School.

Jay L. Nelson, president of the school, notes that the institution has "many, many calls from doctors and hospitals" seeking practical nurses.

A visit to the school and its pleasant and well equipped nurse training section brings some interesting notes on "practical" nursing.

Presently 23 women, ranging from less than 20 years of age to grandmothers, are studying at the school. And they list almost that many reasons for taking the course.

One wanted nursing training to better care for children. Another wanted financial security. A "desire to help others" motivated one woman to study the course. Mrs. Edna Price wants to establish a nursing home.

While in Peru with her husband who works for the Morrison - Knudsen Construction Co., Mrs. Mary Love was confined to the hospital. "There was such a scarcity of skilled help," she said. On future overseas assignments I'll be prepared to help, she said.
