## PRACTICAL NURSING

The Department of Practical Nursing opened in September, 1948, under the direction of the State Board for Vocational Education. The program is fully accredited by national and state practical nursing education agencies.

A practical nurse is a person prepared by an approved educational program to function as a member of the Health Team in individualized and comprehensive nursing care under the direction of a registered, professional nurse or a licensed physician.

Practical nursing students study nursing principles and skills, personal and community health, body structure and function, conditions of illness, nutrition and diet therapy, nursing pharmacology, interpersonal relations, and the care of medical, surgical, obstetric, pediatric, and geriatric patients.

One year is required to complete the course in practical nursing. Training includes 50 weeks of extensive class work and clinical experience at the Salt Lake Trade Technical Institute, the L.D.S. Hospital, the Salt Lake General Hospital, the Primary Children's Hospital, and the Holy Cross Hospital.

Each student must complete 1760 hours of class work and clinical experience to qualify for a certificate. Graduates must pass the state examination to become a licensed practical nurse.

The licensed practical nurse is helping to relieve the critical nursing shortage by giving nursing care in hospitals, assisting in homes, doctors' offices and clinics. Approximately 90% of our graduates are currently employed in the local hospitals.

A new class in Practical Nursing begins in September of each year.
